Important exam information. Please read carefully:

- Exams will run on Monday 18th March, Tuesday 19th March, Thursday 21st March, Friday 22nd March and Monday 25th March.
- **You will be on study leave on Monday 18th and Tuesday 19th March ONLY.** Only come in for those exams you have for those days – you are to study at home if you do not have an exam in any given exam slot on those days. If you need to be in school, you bring revision materials to study at the back of the exam hall. Go directly to the exam hall/exam room at least 10 minutes before each of your exams start.
- **On Wednesday 20th March, you will have no exams** – you are to come to school as normal on that day and follow your timetabled lessons, following registration in your form class.
- **On Wednesday and Thursday there are Geography field trips planned.** Some of the Geography pupils travelling on Thursday will miss their exams for that day. Please see Mrs Wasson as soon as possible to receive an alternative time for these Thursday exams.
- **On Thursday 21st March, Friday 22nd March and Monday 25th March, you will be in normal timetabled classes when you have no exam.** If you have an exam you must make sure you are there promptly at 8.45am/10.20am/12.55pm following your registration/break/lunch. If you are finished an exam and have been dismissed by the exams invigilator, please go directly to your class on your school timetable. Do not wander around the school.
- **All exams will be held in the Youth Centre except English, Maths and RE.** The arrangements for these examinations are as follows:
 - 11CEGK to Boys' Gym
 - 11HLM to Youth Centre
- **Art (2hrs)** will take place on Thursday 21st March from 1pm – 3pm in Rooms 142 & 143
- **French oral examinations (15mins each)** will take place on Tuesday 12th March. French candidates please check your individual times and locations with your French teachers.
- Bring all necessary equipment: calculators, pens etc. to your examination.
- **NO** electronic equipment/mobile phones are permitted in the Exam Hall. Any smart watches must be turned off and put on top of the desk.
