School Nurse information If your child is feeling unwell, they should NOT call home if they feel unwell, they should attend the nurse. Currently a number of pupils are calling parents to go home, and parents are arriving at school to collect their child, and no one knows about it. A lot of the time it is the nurse's clinical judgement that these pupils are well enough to sustain in school. Also, if a pupil has an appointment, a note needs to be sent in and given to form teacher. This information should not be received via a phone call to school on the day of the appointment unless it is an emergency appointment.
