We are having a joint Year 10 parent consultation and GCSE subject choice event. The event will begin with a short presentation in the assembly hall at 12:45pm to 1pm. The event will also have a prompt finish at 3pm. Please note that we along with all other schools are currently operating in a time of industrial action, your understanding is much appreciated as we continue to provide a high-quality education for your child.
