#### **General Information:**

Free Breakfast: The free breakfast will continue for all year groups, daily from 8am to 8.30am in the school canteen.

#### **EXAMINATIONS:**

<u>Art Examinations</u>: Year 12 CCEA GCSE exam is Monday 20<sup>th</sup> March and Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> March both days start at 8.40am and end at 3pm and will be held in your Art Classroom. Those pupils entitled to extra time will attend Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 8.40am to 11.30am. Deadline for all work to be handed in is Monday 17<sup>th</sup> April.

Year 13 & 14 CCEA AS and A2 exam is Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> March, Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> March and Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March all three days start at 8.40am and end at 3pm and will be held in your Art Classroom. Those pupils entitled to extra time will attend Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> March 8.40am to 12.40am. Deadline for all work to be handed in is Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> May.

<u>Single Award Science Practical Exam</u>: Pupils in Mr Hill's and Mr Wray's classes will be completing their practical exam on **Friday 24**<sup>th</sup> **March**, **periods 7-10**. It is essential that all pupils are present for this and during the week for preparation.

<u>Business Studies Controlled Assessment Exam</u>: The Booklet B exam paper for Business Studies Controlled Assessment will take place on **Monday, 27**<sup>th</sup> **March in R235**. Students in **12B** should arrive promptly to start their exam at **8.50**am. Students in **12D** will need to **take an early break from 10.05** am **to 10.20** am as they will start their exam at **10.30**am. It is very important that students attend on this date to complete their exam.

Year 11 Digital Technology class: As discussed on Year 11 Parents Afternoon, Miss Nevin will be running an after-school class for Year 11 Digital Technology pupils to support pupils in having the best chance of success in Module 1 on 18th May. The classes will continue Wednesdays at 3pm until 4pm and run until their module on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> May. It would be highly beneficial for your child to attend these classes.

<u>CCEA Advanced Information</u>: On Monday 27th February, CCEA released Advance Information to help students with their preparation for the exams in May and June. They have produced a presentation and a digital poster to help explain what this information is. *Please find attached*.

#### **OUTSIDE AGENCIES:**

EMA advance notice: Eligibility courses starting 2023/24 FAO Year 12 and Year 13: If you decide to stay on at school or go to a further education college in Northern Ireland, you may be able to get the Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA). It is available for both academic and vocational courses. EMA is a weekly award of £30 which is paid fortnightly to students who meet the eligibility criteria laid out in the leaflet attached. It is intended to help cover the day-to-day costs that you must meet when you stay on at school or college like travel costs, books and equipment for your course.

Please read the attached leaflet to see if you qualify for the scheme. Application packs will be available soon. The school is only allocated a limited number of packs, so please read the information ahead of their release to ensure we can direct the packs to those who will need them. You do not have to have a firm plan for September 2023. Successful applications can be transferred to another learning centre if necessary. If you are in Year 13 and already receive EMA you do not need to reapply for 2023/24. If you are in Year 13 and were not eligible this year but think your circumstances might change for the new academic year, please read the *leaflet attached* for the most up to date information.
