Important Information:

BLACK font in the table indicates this is an external exam – an actual GCSE or BTEC examination.

BLUE font indicates this is an internal school examination.

RED font is information on revision sessions.

Arrival to all external examinations on time is vital. As a school we have no control over the start times of examinations.

Normal lessons will continue throughout the months of May and June 2023 except for Thursday 18th May 2023 to Tuesday 23rd May 2023 (*inclusive*) when pupils should only attend school on the days they have examinations and scheduled revision lessons (please see the table for more details). If your child needs to travel on a school bus to school at the normal time we will provide a room to study in before examinations start. Your child needs to communicate this to his/her class teacher who will then inform the relevant staff.

Your child should highlight the subjects they study to ensure they know which examinations and revision sessions are relevant to them.

Mobile phones or any electronic devices are not to be taken into the examination halls. These can be given in to the school office in advance of examinations starting (if this facility is needed pupils must arrive at the office, well in advance of the examination start time).

Your child's safety is paramount therefore we advise parents to ensure that their children do not visit coffee shops; other shops or the park in Ballyclare before or after examinations.

Pupils are not to be signed out after examinations as it is vitally important that your child continues to work hard in all lessons during the months of May and June.
