EMA Update: After a long delay at the EMA Customer Service side, EMA application packs are now available from the office. Year 13 pupils already in receipt of EMA do not need to reapply. If you think you are eligible please collect a pack before the 30 June and apply over the summer, this will mean there are less likely to be delays in starting payments come September. Forms are not returned to the school but rather to the address given in the pack/application notes. Remember you do not need to be sure where you will study or even if you will continue in education at all. If you apply and move to a different learning centre it straightforward to make that change and will take significantly less time than if you wait to apply from scratch come September. These groups have been very popular with parents and provide an online space for parents to meet and discuss shared parenting experiences, listen to stories of others, and support one another, parent to parent. For the attention of Year 13 female pupils: The Smallpeice Trust is an educational charity encouraging young people to pursue careers in engineering, inspiring young minds to follow their passion for STEM subjects since 1966. We are currently recruiting 14 to 17-year-old students for the National Cyber Security Centre's (NCSC) CyberFirst summer course programme. Inspired and led by the NCSC, a part of GCHQ, CyberFirst is a programme of opportunities to help young people explore their passion for tech by introducing them to the fast-paced world of cyber security. Each course is designed to inspire and encourage students from all backgrounds to explore and consider careers in cyber security, offering young people with potential the support, skills, experience and exposure needed to be the future first line of defence in our CyberFirst world. There are currently a limited number of Year 13 girls places available on the CyberFirst Advanced Belfast course (7-11 August) which is a fully-funded, five-day residential course aimed at attracting a diverse range of students need to enter the cyber security or tech-based workplace for real. The course is designed to expland the knowledge of students already studying computer science or who have a passion and aptitude for all things tech. Gaining skills in key areas including digital forensics, encryption technologies, penetration testing and open-source intelligence techniques. 
