PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

- Most exams will be held in the assembly hall or gymnasium. However, **exact location of exams will be displayed on the school exam information board** in the pupil entrance hall each morning – please check upon arrival to school where you need to go.
- Pupils will be on study leave during the exam session and should only attend school if they have an exam. **The lecture theatre will be open** to pupils wishing to avail of study time between exams. Year 13 pupils should NOT be anywhere else in the school building other than for an exam or for revision.
- The canteen will be available for lunch between 11.45am and 12.25pm, should you wish to use it.
- Please ensure you arrive for your exams promptly – at least 5 minutes before the 9am, 10.30am and 12.25pm starting times.
- Please note: If you require time to complete any exams beyond the 2.55pm finish and normally travel home by bus, please ensure you have made alternative arrangements to get home.
- Bring all necessary equipment: calculators, pens etc. to your examination.
- Written examinations should be completed in **black pen**, as per external exam regulations. Please bring 2 pens in case one runs out.
- NO electronic equipment/mobile phones are permitted in the Exam Hall. This includes watches with ‘Smart’ technology.
- If school bags are brought into school, these should be left at the back of the youth centre hall before an exam and collected again when finished.
- Clear plastic bottles of water are permitted in the hall – no other drink bottles are allowed.
- Pencil cases must be clear with no labels.
