Qualification Requirements

Four GCSE passes in the following subjects:

Mathematics*	minimum Grade C
English Language	minimum Grade C
Science or a Technology based subject	minimum Grade C
Any other subject	minimum Grade C

Preference may be given to candidates with a minimum Grade B or C in Maths.

Essential Skills, Key Skills or City & Guilds, at the appropriate level, will also be considered as acceptable equivalents.

Applicants should be aware that the selection of successful candidates will be made in accordance with the eligibility criteria for the funding of the Apprenticeships NI 2021 programme, as set out by the Department for the Economy.

The selection process may include online aptitude tests and an interview. Please note the primary means of communication will be email (please remember to check your Spam folder).
