## **Ballyclare Secondary School**

Application for Admission to Year 13 2024/2025



### Criteria for Admission to Year 13

To gain entry to Sixth Form, students must:

- i. Achieve a minimum of 5 'C' grades or equivalent at Level 2, including at least a Grade C in GCSE English **and** Mathematics. Pupils may be admitted to Sixth Form if they have achieved a grade C in Maths or English and are able to prove that the missing grade is imminently attainable (through remark or resit and supported by the relevant HOD).
- ii. A minimum of **8 points** from **5 Level 2 qualifications** calculated on the basis of results as follows:

# Qualifications in Occupational Studies, Preparation for Adult Life and Prince's Trust are each allocated one point for return sixth form if passed at Level 2.

- iii. Meet the essential criteria set out for each subject.
- iv. Choose and complete three subjects (or equivalent) over the two years.
- v. Have a history of good attendance, punctuality and behaviour.\*
- NB. Applicants must also meet the <u>individual subject criteria</u> as specified in the Year 13 Options Booklet.

#### **Oversubscription:**

If there are more pupils eligible than there are places available in the school, places shall be awarded in the following order:

1. Applicants with the highest GCSE score – an applicant's GCSE score being calculated on the basis of GCSE results on the following points system:

A\*= 7, A = 6, B = 5, C\*= 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1

- 2. In the event of a tie, priority will be established by computerised random selection.
- 3. The Board of Governors reserve the right to admit pupils where there are verifiable Exceptional Circumstances.

Class sizes in Post 16 courses do not normally exceed 16. If there are more pupils eligible than there are places available in a course, places shall be awarded in the following order:

- 1. Applicants with the highest GCSE score in the relevant subjects as outlined in the Options Booklet.
- 2. The Board of Governors reserve the right to admit pupils where there are verifiable Exceptional Circumstances.


