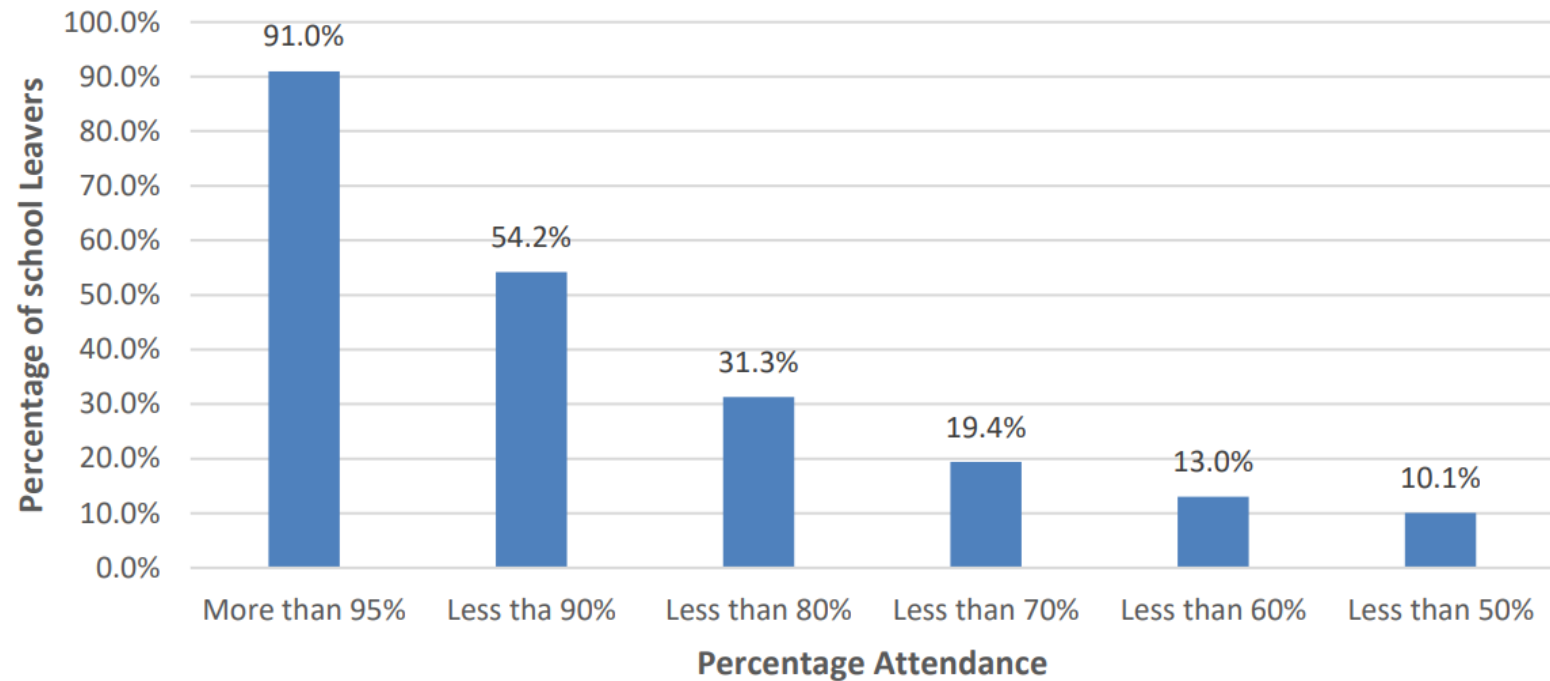

# Attendance at School

## EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS

Every single day a child is absent from school equates to a day of lost learning.

<b>100% Attendance</b>	<b>0 Days Missed</b>
<b>95% Attendance</b>	<b>9 Days of Absence 1 Week and 4 Days of Learning Missed</b>
<b>90% Attendance</b>	<b>19 Days of Absence 3 Weeks and 4 Days of Learning Missed</b>
<b>85% Attendance</b>	<b>28 Days of Absence 5 Weeks and 3 Days of Learning Missed</b>

# Target Setting - CAT4

- Cognitive ability test - 4 batteries

VERBAL REASONING

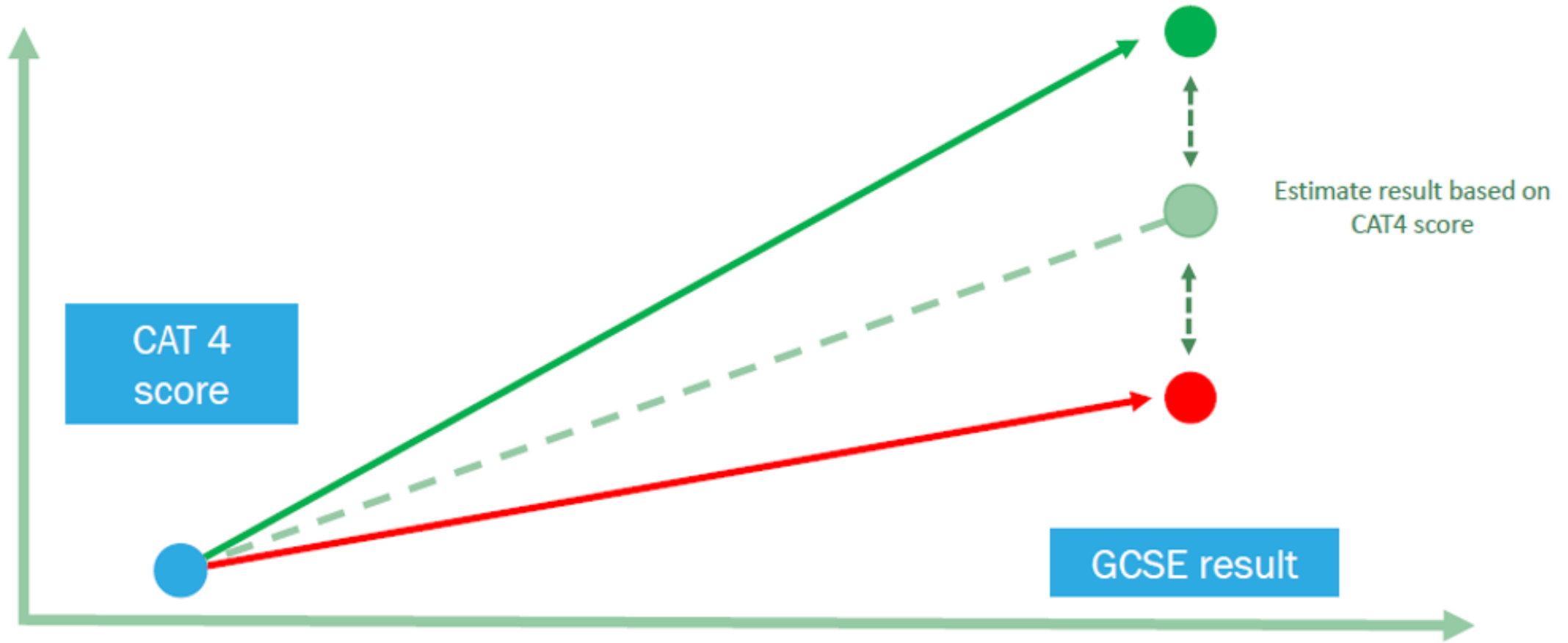
- Three 45 minute tests

CATN provides individual profiles of a student's **strengths and areas for development** across the batteries



# Initial expectation

- ▶ The **CAT4** test provides likely outcomes in all subjects for each individual student.... even for subjects that the student hasn't previously studied, for example 'Childcare'!
- ▶ For each subject, pupils will receive an '**Initial expectation**' grade, or level, which is calculated from the likely outcomes that the **CAT4** test provides. Subject teachers will talk through these grades with pupils.



# Pupil Report

Initial expectation – All pupils complete computerised baseline testing. Initial expectation grades are calculated from the results of these tests.

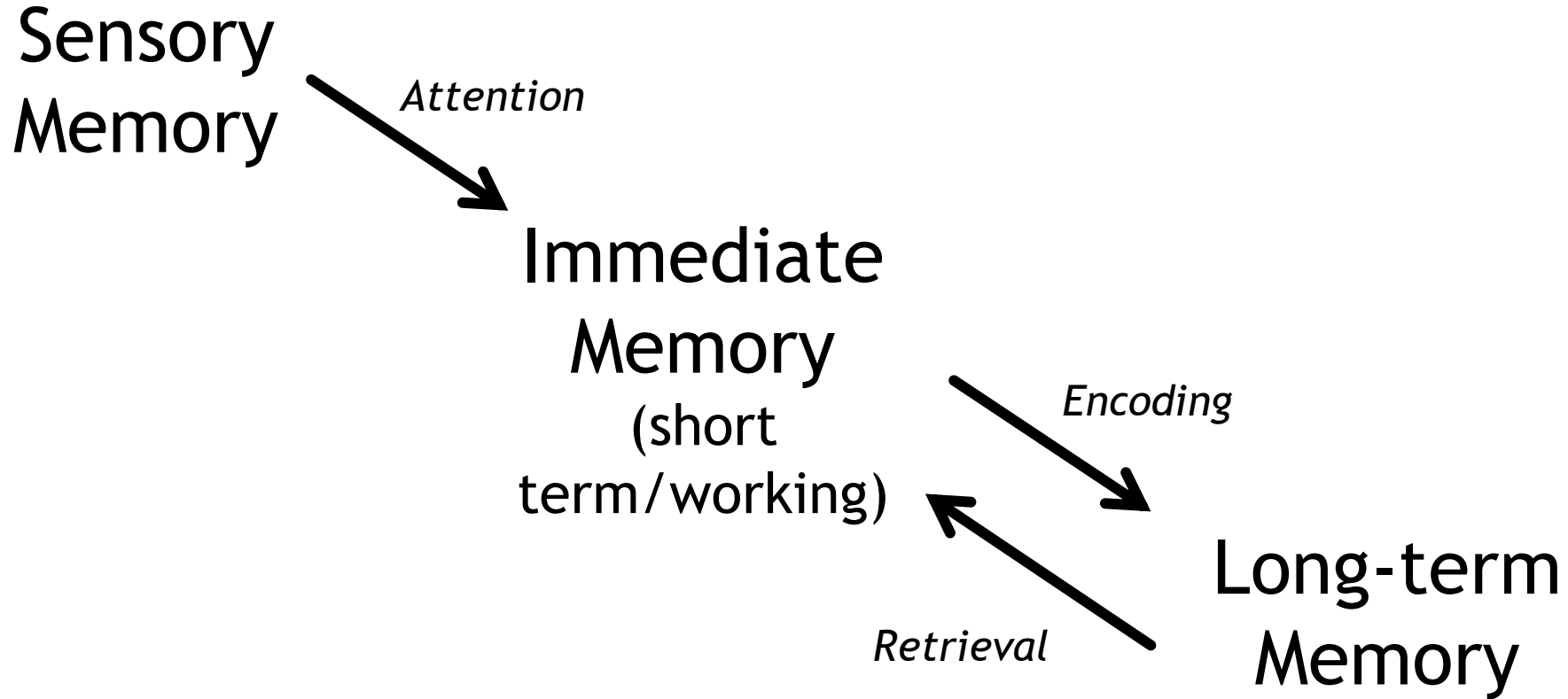

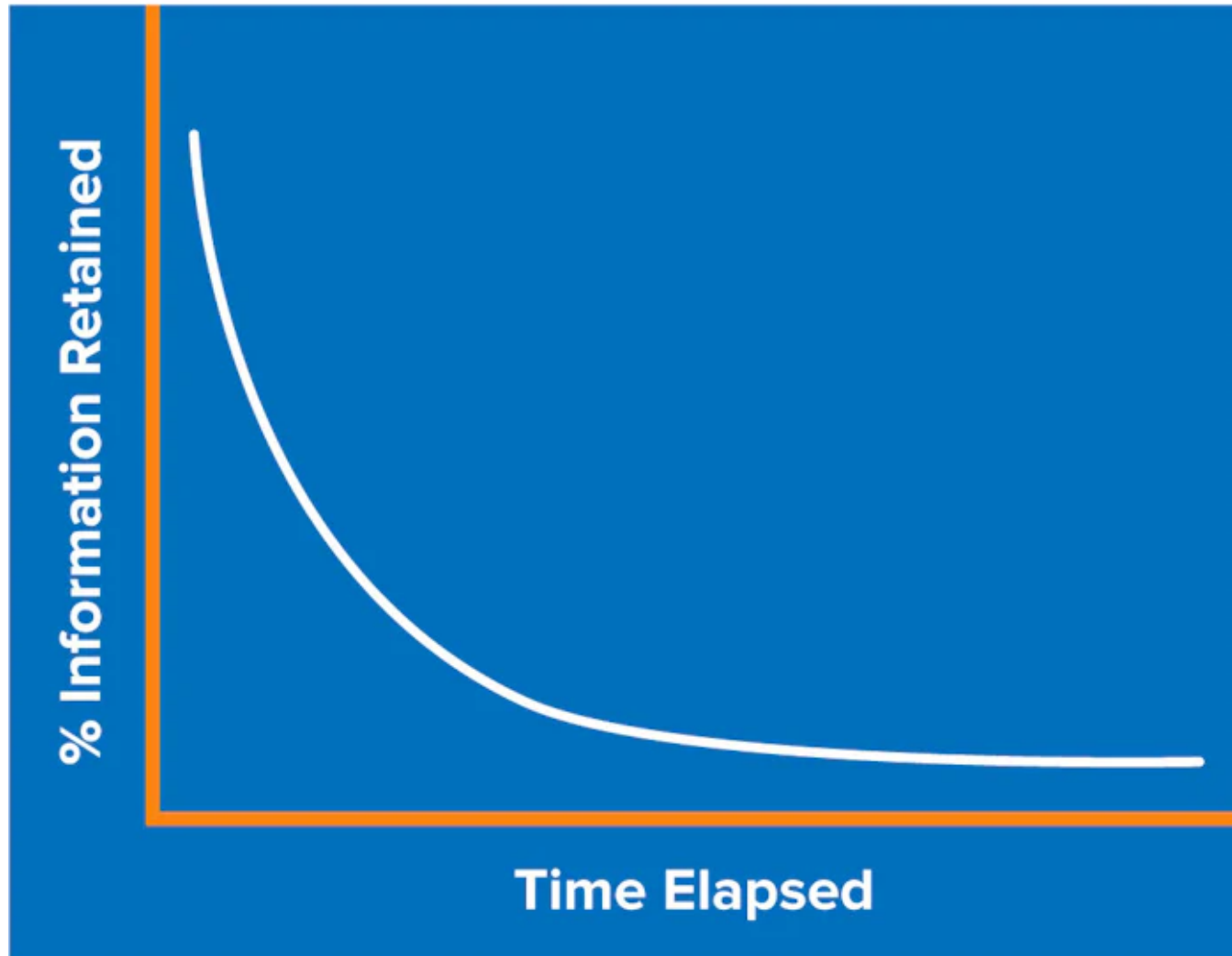

# Retaining Information

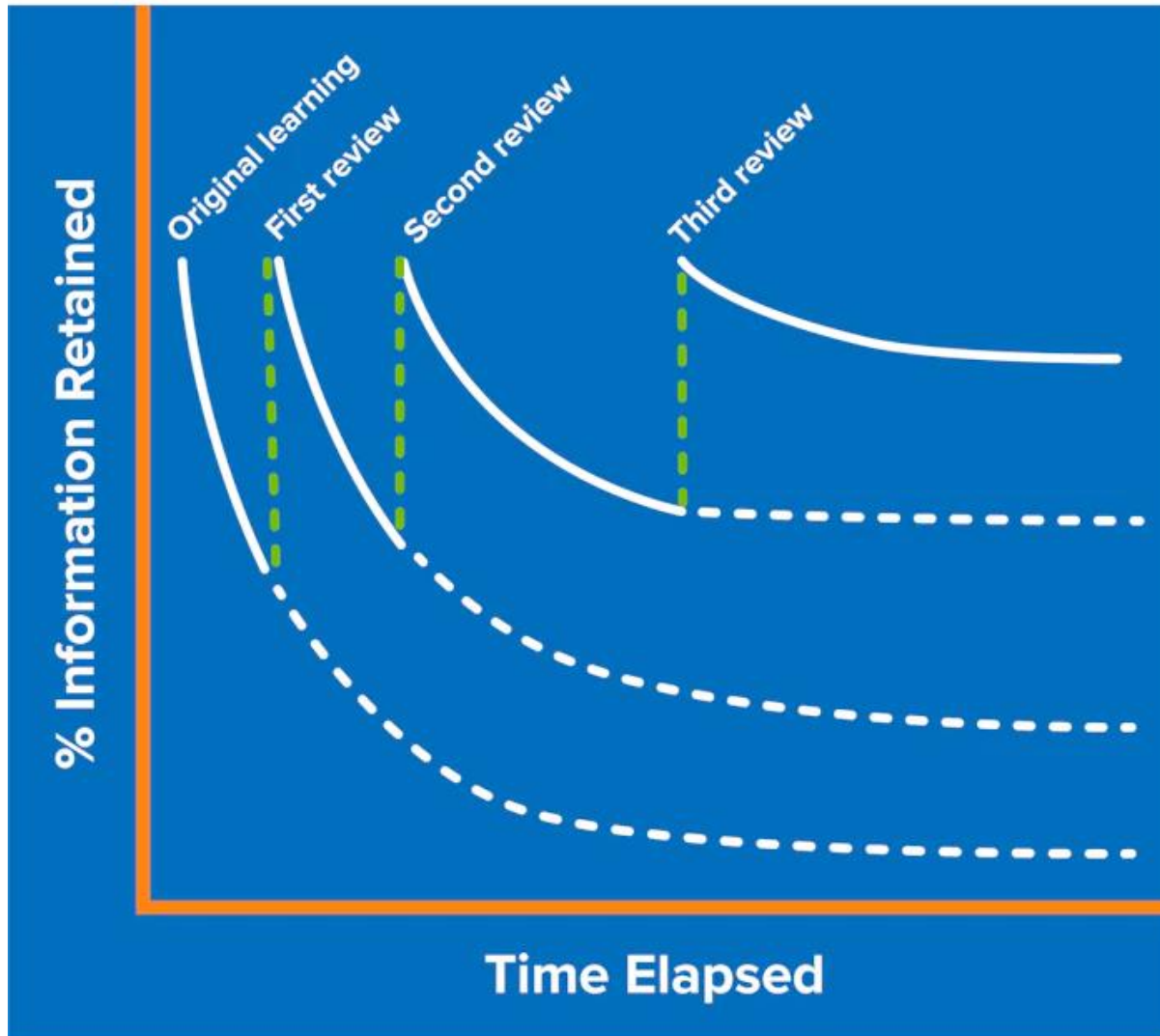


Without review, only 25% of learned material is retained after one week.

Neuroplasticity - teenage brains are malleable

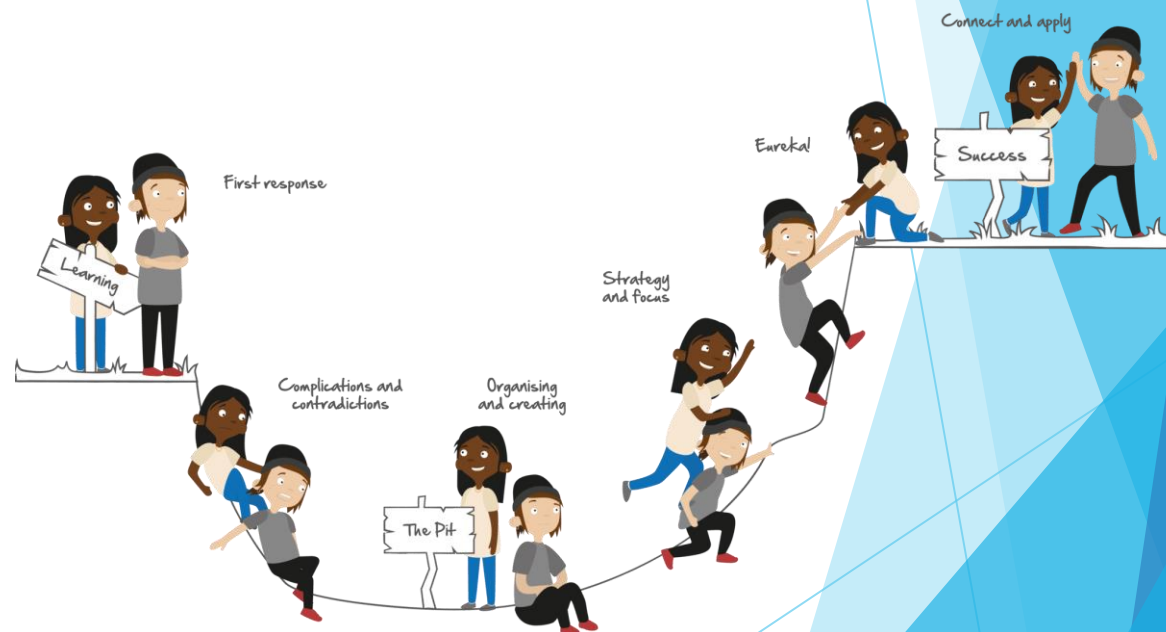
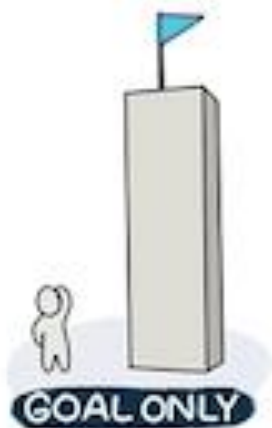
